

ORDER

This Action¹ is before the Court upon Plaintiffs’ Unopposed Motion to Extend Claims Deadline (Doc. 1175). On February 26, 2020, the Court set the deadline to file claims for the settlements with Bausch & Lomb, Inc. and CooperVision, Inc. as March 3, 2020 (Doc. 1155). On February 29, 2020, Settlement Administrator Epiq Class Action & Claims Solutions, Inc. (Epiq) experienced a cyber-incident that resulted in the claim form website being unavailable to potential claimants on March 3, 2020. Plaintiffs represent that the claim form website is now back online and available to potential claimants. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

Epiq may continue to receive and process claims until **March 31, 2020**.
